








Culture and the Bible

- 3. ID theological principle
- 4. How does the theological principle fit with the rest of the Bible?
- 5. Apply principles





Cultural Conditioning and the Bible

- "The ultimate issue here is this: To what extent is the Bible's relevance and authority limited by changing human structures and perspectives in the bible text?" (116)
- Value of understanding biblical culture questions of language, style, genre, author, syntax and propositions, AND context



Cultural Conditioning and the Reader

- Be aware of our own culture and presuppositions
- Acknowledge your own biases
- Instead of criticizing Scripture, Scripture should criticize you
- Read both historical and modern helpful sources
- Avoid the existential method and over contextualization
- Reject esoteric "illumination" like the plague!!!
